- Started in 1997




Cuyahoga & Summit Counties

 Public Schools (forth graders)
- Volunteers: Program supported
 by over 60 volunteers providing
 2300 hours of service annually
- **Location:** along Towpath Trail within CVNP
- Program frequency: 4 weeks per year, May & October
- Education: included about safety, natural & cultural park resources









Unique partnership between
Cycling School, CVNP,
Conservancy for CVNP, United
Airlines employees, Century
Cycles, & Akron Bike Club.
Provides outdoor activity & bike
safety for kids who otherwise may
never come to the National Park.
Strengthens volunteer program,
volunteers have recently formed

their own 501 C 3 & participate in other park programs.


