PHASE II - Shoreline Restoration & Recreational Trails



- **Type** All-purpose, paved
- **Length** $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile
- **Cost** \$10M
- **Funding Sources** Federal, State and Local grants including FEMA, Great Lakes Commission, OhioEPA, State Capital allocation, ODNR (Coastal Management, Clean Ohio Trails Fund, Recreational Trails Fund, Natureworks, Land and Water Conservation Funds), and Cuyahoga County Casino Revenue Funds.

PHASE II - Shoreline Restoration & Recreational Trails



- **Amenities** provides unprecedented 3,600 linear feet of public access to a privatized shoreline; creates a new lakefront park at the east trailhead, **Connections to other non- project assets** connects accessible trails to Downtown Euclid, Lakefront Bikeway, cultural (Henn Mansion) and recreational (disk golf) amenities, fishing pier in Sims Park. Private and public stairs/ramps to trail.

II. PUBLIC TRAIL & SHORELINE




Unique!

- **Benefits to the Public** Over 100 property owners signed long-term Easement Agreements with the City, mitigation their erosion and enabling waterfront property as a public asset.
- **Environmental** 1600 SF bio-retention basin, reduced nutrient load into Lake Erie by 102,000 gallons yearly, adds 5 acres of cobble beach, upland native prairie and nearshore aquatic habitat.

- **Social Equity** majority-minority community, over 1400 low-moderate income housing units within a five minute walk
