

- **Benefits to the Public**: Off-road bicycle and pedestrian access to residential and recreational locations
- Environmental enhancements:
 Constructed wetlands, dry detention basins, and landscaping are included in the Lakefront West project
- Social Equity: Increasing access for historically marginalized residents,
 especially those without cars, to natural and recreational amenities; increasing multi-modal connectivity across the near West side of Cleveland
