- Connects 32 miles of the Emerald Necklace Trail, from the tip of Rocky River Reservation in Lakewood to the Cuyahoga Valley National Park via Brecksville Reservation
- Partnership with three municipalities from planning study through construction
















Valley Parkway Connector Trail (Phases I & II)

- Benefits to the Public:

- Environmental enhancements:
 Relocated existing bridle trail to north side of parkway to lessen impacts
- Social Equity: Extends access to an area not well served by active transportation
