
- Neighborhood residents adjacent to event routes and participants from around Greater Cleveland

- Staff & volunteers: Organized by 3 'staff volunteers;' planned by neighborhood teams; produced with the help of ~50 dedicated volunteers
- Location: Neighborhood streets in Cleveland
- **Program frequency:** Once per month in the summer























- Benefits, Goals, and Results:
 - Increased active transportation behaviors: people remember how fun and easy it is to walk and bike!
 - Public health: participants are more physically active than they would be otherwise
 - Social cohesion: neighbors meet each other as equals to celebrate their community
- **Transferability:** Open Streets can happen in any community. Permitting requirements may vary.


