

Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail








Towpath Trail in Cleveland!





Treadway Creek Greenway & Trail





- Completed spring 2008 total project cost \$1.3 million
- Linking 30,000 Old Brooklyn residents to the Towpath Trail





Morgana Run Trail



- Completed fall 2006 total project cost \$2.5 million
- Turning 3.5 miles of vacant railroad property into new greenspace
- Linking Broadway neighborhoods to recreational opportunities

Complete Streets / Green Streets

- Ordinance No. 798-11
- Approved by Cleveland City Council on September 19, 2011
- Effective January 1, 2012
 - What is a "Complete Street"?

A Complete Street is safe, comfortable and convenient for travel via automobile, foot, bicycle, and transit.

- What is a "Complete Streets" policy?
- A complete streets policy ensures that the entire right of way is routinely designed and operated to enable safe access for all users

- \$2.5 million








Lake-to-Lakes Trail

- 1¼ miles, \$1.6 million









Cleveland's first "velodrome" (under construction)



Lorain – Carnegie Bridge




